Wishon Branch of the Tule River Walk

Elevation change 3,000ft during drive and 500ft maximum walking. Bring water, lunch, sunscreen, hat, and good walking shoes. Walk is on a narrow informal trail not suitable for children under 10. The trail is a mostly shady trail along the river. We will stop for lunch. There is a possibility of poison oak along the trail. The walk passes through a number of plant communities. This is an area where ladybugs congregate.

Join us for the 2nd annual Long Meadow stroll! This year, Tyler Schmidt from Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Parks will help lead the hike with Ann Huber along Long Meadow, one of the most gentle and botanically lovely walks in the front country. The trail is flat to gently sloping less than 2 mile loop around the open Long Meadow, with shaded portions that dip into the surrounding upper mixed conifer forest. This is a field trip for all ages, so bring the whole family. Bring a lunch to eat before the stroll, water, sunscreen, and a hat.
